INAUGURATION OF SRIJANI – A LIVELIHOOD HUB AT MOHIT NAGAR

DECEMBER 20, 2021: Star Cement organised an inauguration program of Srijani, the Livelihood Hub at Mohitnagar area on **18th December, 2021** under the gracious presence of the Special invited Guests including Guests of Honour. The objective of inauguration program of SRIJANI-Livelihood Hub is to disseminate information about upcoming different CSR initiative under Livelihood and Skill Development component. The objective of setting up Livelihood Hub is to generate employability for 200 youths within a span of next one year by implementing several livelihood initiatives like Bakery Production Unit, Agarbatti Production, Biofloc Farming and Handy-crafts Making Project etc. Beautician training, Tailoring, Embroidery training, etc. Under this project, the selected youths will be trained and will be given an opportunity to earn monthly income, yearly dividend. The capital cost of setting up each unit like Agarbatti making unit, Bakery unit, Bio floc unit, Menstrual Hygiene unit, tailoring and Beautician training will be borne by Star Cement and training will be imparted free of cost. On the Job training will be imparted within the Livelihood Hub and all trainees will be given an opportunity to earn their consistent income for which capital and recurring cost will be borne by Star Cement.

Name of all projects were announced and displayed in front of all trainees and communities. Smt. Mahua Gope, TMC District President, the chief guests on the occasion had praised star Cement for encouraging youths to upscale their skill set and to create a conducive environment for generating alternative livelihood.
