NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the Shareholders of STAR CEMENT LIMITED ("the Company") pursuant to Section 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("the Rules") (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by The Institute of Company Secretaries of India ('SS-2'), as amended, and in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') vide its General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022 and 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022, 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023, 09/2024 dated 19th September, 2024 and 03/2025 dated 22nd September, 2025 (collectively the 'MCA Circulars') and pursuant to other applicable provisions of the laws and regulations (including any Statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force as amended from time to time), that the resolutions as set out in this Notice are proposed for consideration by the members through postal ballot by way of voting through electronic means (remote e-voting).

The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act, pertaining to the said resolutions setting out the material facts and the reasons thereof is annexed to this Postal Ballot Notice for your consideration.

In terms of the requirements specified in the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending this Notice in electronic form only, to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/ Depositories/ Registrar and Share Transfer Agents. Accordingly, physical copy of the Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope are not being sent to the Members for this Postal Ballot. The shareholders would have option to vote only through remote e-voting and voting through physical ballot will not be available. The communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would only take place through the remote e-voting system.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and 110 of the Act read with the Rules, the MCA Circulars and SS-2, the Company is providing remote e-voting facility to its Members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically. The Company has engaged the services of National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") for the purpose of providing remote e-voting facility to its Members. The instructions for remote e-voting are appended to this Notice. The Notice is also available on the website of the Company www.starcement.co.in.

The voting through electronic means will commence on Sunday, 19th October, 2025 at 9:00 A.M. (IST) and will end on Monday, 17th November, 2025 at 5:00 P.M. (IST).

Members are requested to read carefully the instructions specified in the postal ballot notice and to cast their vote through the remote e-voting process not later than **5.00 P.M. (IST) on Monday, 17th November, 2025** to be eligible for being considered, failing which it will be strictly considered that no vote has been received from the concerned shareholder. The remote e-voting facility will be disabled by NSDL immediately thereafter.

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Rules, the Board of Directors, has appointed **Mr. Raj Kumar Banthia** (ACS 17190/CP-18428) and failing him **Mr. Manoj Kumar Banthia** (ACS-11470/CP-7596) both of **M/s. MKB & Associates**, a firm of Practicing Company Secretaries (FRN: P2010WB042700), to act as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot process through remote e-voting in a fair and transparent manner.

In accordance with the provisions of the MCA Circulars, Members can vote only through the remote e-voting process. Members opting to vote by postal ballot through electronic means are requested to read carefully the instructions specified in the postal ballot notice.

Based on the Scrutinizer's Report, the Results of the Postal Ballot through e-voting will be declared on or before **Wednesday, 19th November, 2025 by 5.00 P.M. (IST)** at the Registered Office of the Company. The declared Results, along with the Scrutinizer's Report, will be available on the Company's corporate website www.starcement.co.in and will also be forwarded to the Stock Exchanges where the Company's shares are listed i.e., BSE Limited ("**BSE**") & National Stock Exchange of India Limited ("**NSE**") herein after collectively referred to as "**Stock Exchanges**". "RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23, 41, 42, 62(1)(a), 62(1)(c), 71, 179 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("**Companies Act**"), the Companies (Prospectus and Allotment of Securities) Rules, 2014, the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014 and other applicable rules made thereunder (including any amendment(s), statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof), the provisions of the Memorandum of Association and the Articles of Association of the Company and in accordance with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, as amended ("**SEBI ICDR Regulations**"), the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("**SEBI Listing Regulations**"), the listing agreements entered into by the Company with BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited ("**Stock Exchanges**") on which the equity shares having face value of ₹ 1 each of the Company ("**Equity Shares**") are listed, the provisions of the

Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and rules and regulations framed thereunder, as amended ("**FEMA**"), including the Foreign Exchange Management (Non-debt Instruments) Rules, 2019, as amended, Foreign Exchange Management (Debt Instruments) Rules, 2019, as amended, the Issue of Foreign Currency Convertible Bonds and Ordinary Shares (Through Depository Receipt Mechanism) Scheme, 1993, as amended, the Depository Receipts Scheme, 2014, as amended, the extant Consolidated FDI Policy issued by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue and Listing of Non-Convertible Securities) Regulations, 2021, as amended, ("**Debt Listing Regulations**"), the Reserve Bank of India Master Directions on Foreign Investment in India, 2018 and subject to other applicable rules, regulations and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("**MCA**"), the relevant Registrar of Companies, Securities and Exchange Board of India ("**SEBI**"), Reserve Bank of India ("**RBI**"), Government of India ("**GoI**"), Stock Exchanges and / or any competent statutory, regulatory, governmental or any other authorities, whether in India or abroad (herein referred to as "**Applicable Regulatory Authorities**"), from time to time and to the extent applicable, subject to such approvals, permissions, consents and sanctions as may be necessary or required from the Applicable Regulatory Authorities in this regard and further subject to such terms and conditions or modifications as may be prescribed or imposed by any or all of them while granting any such approvals, permissions, consents and / or sanctions, which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the "**Board**", which term shall include Fund Raising Committee to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution), consent, authority and approval of the Board, be and is hereby accorded to create, offer, issue and allot (including with provisions for reservations on firm and/ or competitive basis, or such part of issue and for such categories of persons, including employees, as may be permitted) with or without green shoe option, such number of Equity Shares and equity linked instruments, including convertible preference shares, non-convertible debt instruments along with warrants, fully convertible debentures, partly convertible debentures, and/or any other securities convertible into Equity Shares (including warrants or otherwise), Global Depository Receipts ("**GDRs**"), American Depository Receipts ("**ADRs**"), Foreign Currency Convertible Bonds ("**FCCBs**"), (all of which are hereinafter collectively referred to as "**Securities**") or any combination of Securities, in one or more tranches, whether Rupee denominated or denominated in one or more foreign currencies in the course of international and / or domestic offerings, in one or more foreign markets and/or domestic markets, through public and/or private offerings and/or rights offering and/ or by way of Qualified Institutions Placement ("**QIP**"), or any combination thereof, through issue of prospectus and/or preliminary placement document, placement document and/or other permissible/ requisite offer documents to any eligible person, including Qualified Institutional Buyers ("**QIBs**") as defined under the SEBI ICDR Regulations, in accordance with Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, or otherwise, including foreign/resident investors (whether institutions, incorporated bodies, mutual funds, individuals or otherwise), venture capital funds (foreign or Indian), alternate investment funds, foreign institutional investors, foreign portfolio investors, qualified foreign investors, Indian and/or multilateral financial institutions, mutual funds, non-resident Indians, stabilizing agents, pension funds and/or any other categories of investors, whether they be holders of Securities of the Company or not (collectively called the "**Investors**"), as may be decided by the Board in its discretion and permitted under applicable laws and regulations, for

an aggregate consideration of up to ₹,1500 crore (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred crore only) (inclusive of such premium as may be fixed on such Securities) at such time or times, at such price or prices, at a discount or premium to market price or prices, as permitted under applicable laws and in such manner and on such terms and conditions including security, rate of interest etc. and any other matters incidental thereto as may be deemed appropriate by the Board at its absolute discretion including the discretion to determine the categories of Investors to whom the offer, issue and allotment of Securities shall be made to the exclusion of other categories of Investors at the time of such creation, offer, issue and allotment considering the prevailing market conditions and other relevant factors and wherever necessary in consultation with lead manager(s) and/or underwriter(s) and/or other advisor(s) appointed and/or to be appointed by the Board, in foreign currency and/ or equivalent Indian Rupees as may be determined by the Board, or in any convertible foreign currency, as the Board in its absolute discretion may deem fit and appropriate (the “**Issue**”) and without requiring any further approval or consent from the members at the time of such issue and allotment;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, in case of issue and allotment of Securities by way of QIP in terms of Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “**Eligible Securities**” within the meaning rendered to such term under Regulation 171(a) of the SEBI ICDR Regulations):

1. The allotment of Securities shall only be made to qualified institutional buyers as defined under SEBI ICDR Regulations (“**QIBs**”);
2. The Eligible Securities to be so created, offered, issued, and allotted, shall be subject to the provisions of the Memorandum of Association and the Articles of Association of the Company;
3. The allotment of the Eligible Securities, or any combination of the Eligible Securities as may be decided by the Board and subject to applicable laws, shall be completed within 365 days from the date of passing of this resolution or such other time as may be allowed under the SEBI ICDR Regulations;
4. The Equity Shares issued and allotted under the Issue or allotted upon conversion of the equity linked instruments issued in QIP shall rank *pari-passu inter se* in all respects including with respect to entitlement to dividend, voting rights or otherwise with the existing Equity Shares of the Company in all respects;
5. The number and/or price of the Eligible Securities or the underlying Equity Shares issued on conversion of Eligible Securities convertible into Equity Shares shall be appropriately adjusted for corporate actions such as bonus issue, rights issue, stock split, merger, demerger, transfer of undertaking, sale of division, reclassification of equity shares into other securities, issue of equity shares by way of capitalisation of profit or reserves, or any such capital or corporate restructuring;
6. The Eligible Securities (excluding warrants) under the QIP shall be issued and allotted as fully paid-up securities, in dematerialised form;
7. In the event Equity Shares are issued, the “relevant date” in accordance with the SEBI ICDR Regulations for the purpose of pricing of the Equity Shares to be issued, shall be the date of the meeting in which the Board or the committee of directors authorised by the

Board decides to open the proposed issue of such Equity Shares, subsequent to the receipt of members' approval in terms of provisions of the Act and other applicable laws, rules, regulations and guidelines in relation to the proposed issue of the Equity Shares;

8. In the event that Eligible Securities issued are eligible convertible securities, the relevant date for the purpose of pricing of the convertible securities to be issued, shall be, either the date of the meeting at which the Board or a committee of directors authorised by the Board decides to open the proposed issue or the date on which the holders of such eligible convertible securities become entitled to apply for Equity Shares, as decided by the Board;
9. The tenure of the convertible or exchangeable Eligible Securities issued through the QIP shall not exceed sixty months from the date of allotment;
10. Issue of Eligible Securities made by way of a QIP shall be at such price which is not less than the price determined in accordance with Regulation 176(1) under Chapter VI of the SEBI ICDR Regulations ("**QIP Floor Price**") and applicable law. The Board may, however, at its absolute discretion in consultation with the lead managers, issue Eligible Securities at a discount of not more than five percent or such other discount as may be permitted under applicable regulations to the QIP Floor Price;
11. No single allottee shall be allotted more than fifty per cent of the issue size and the minimum number of allottees shall be as per the SEBI ICDR Regulations;
12. No allotment shall be made, either directly or indirectly, to any QIB who is a promoter, or any person related to the promoters of the Company;
13. The Eligible Securities allotted in the QIP shall not be eligible for sale by the respective allottees, for a period of one year from the date of allotment, except on a recognized stock exchange or except as may be permitted from time to time by the SEBI ICDR Regulations; and
14. Any subsequent QIP shall not be undertaken until the expiry of two weeks (or such other period as may be prescribed) from the date of the prior QIP made pursuant to this special resolution.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, the Securities issued in foreign markets shall be deemed to have been made abroad and/or in the market and/or at the place of issue of the Securities in the international market and may be governed by the applicable laws;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, in the event of issue of GDRs/ADRs, the pricing shall be determined in compliance with principles and provisions set out in the Issue of Foreign Currency Convertible Bonds and Ordinary Shares (through the Depositary Receipt Mechanism) Scheme 1993, the Companies (Issue of Global Depositary Receipts) Rules, 2014, the Depositary Receipts Scheme, 2014, the Framework for issue of Depositary Receipts notified by SEBI vide circular dated October 10, 2019, as amended and other applicable pricing provisions issued by the Ministry of Finance and other applicable laws, the Relevant Date for the purpose of pricing the Securities to be issued pursuant to such issue shall be the date of the meeting at which the Board decides to open such issue after passing of this Special Resolution. Preferential issuance and allotment of Securities (other than as issued and allotted to QIBs by way of QIP) shall be subject

to the requirements prescribed under the Act and Chapter V of the SEBI ICDR Regulations and other applicable laws;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, the Board and/or a duly authorized committee, be and is hereby authorised to enter into any arrangement with any agencies or bodies for the issue of GDRs and/or ADRs represented by underlying equity shares in the share capital of the Company with such features and attributes as are prevalent in international/domestic capital markets for instruments of this nature and to provide for the tractability and free transferability thereof in accordance with market practices as per the domestic and/or international practice and regulations and under the norms and practices prevalent in the domestic/international capital markets and subject to applicable laws and regulations and the Articles of Association of the Company;
